1.	Demonstrate a knowledge of contraceptive options: mechanisms of action, efficacy, and contraindications.	Medical Expert
2.	Demonstrate a knowledge of different methods of pregnancy termination, including risks, limitations and benefits. Include medical and surgical abortions in the first and second trimesters.	Medical Expert
3.	Formulate a contraceptive plan with a patient considering medical and psycho-social needs.	Communicator, Advocate
4.	Counsel a patient regarding options when encountering an unintended pregnancy.	Communicator, Advocate
